17.00	<b>Ste.Clotilde</b>	Audition (organ concert)	<i>(only second Saturday of the month, September-June)</i>
17.45	<b>Sainte-Madeleine (1846, III/58)</b>	Prelude of the 18.00-Mass	19.00 Take Metro ligne 12 to Solférino and walk to Ste Clotilde (5 minutes)
19.25	<b>Sainte-Clotilde (1859, III/71):</b>	Sortie of Evening Mass	
SUNDAY			
10.00	<b>Ten options</b>	See beneath	Do mind: all preludes are very short, you will have to wait for the offertoire, communion and sortie to hear the organ in all its beauty
12.05	<b>St.Sulpice</b>	Audition (organ concert)	Visit to the organ loft cancelled due to 'security reasons'
16.00	<b>Sacré-Coeur</b>	Vespers	Cavaillé-Coll's last masterpiece, although in a very bad shape nowadays
17.00	<b>St-Eustache</b>	Audition (organ concert)	
18.45	<b>St.Etienne-du-Mont</b>	Evening Mass	Prelude and sortie are short at St. Etienne-du-Mont...
19h	<b>St.Pierre-de-Chailot</b>	Gegorian Mass	With improvisations o the Gregorian songs
22.00	<b>Sacré-Coeur</b>	Mass	Cavaillé-Coll's last masterpiece, although in a very bad condition nowadays

*If you prefer the symphonic organs:*

**St. Etienne-du-Mont – Trinité - Madeleine (10:30) - Notre-Dame-de-la-Croix - Église d'Auteuil (2021/2022: church is being restored, no masses) -  
 St. Bernard de la Chapelle - Saint-Antoine-des-Quinze-Vingts**

*If you prefer French baroque organs:*

**St-Nicolas-des-Champs (in a very bad condition) - St-Roch - St-Gervais**

*If you prefer German baroque organs:*

**St-Louis-en-l'île (2021/22: church is being restored, the organ is hidden)**

#### **Other organs you should visit (but don't fit into any schedule):**

- Saint-Denis (Metro ligne 13) (Sunday 10.00 AM)
- Aubervilliers (Metro ligne 12) (Sunday 9.30, 11.00 AM)
- Versailles, Cathédrale St. Louis (RER C) (Sunday 11.00 AM) *(2021/2022: the organ is being restored)*
